## **2012 Concerto Competition for High School Musicians**

The First Coast Wind Ensemble and Jacksonville University are pleased to announce the FCWE 2012 Concerto Competition for High School Musicians. This young artist event is designed to promote music education in Florida by providing talented students an opportunity to perform a solo work with wind ensemble. The winner will be chosen through a competitive audition process and will perform with the First Coast Wind Ensemble in concert on **April 22, 2012** at Jacksonville University. The winner will receive a \$1,000.00 cash award from the First Coast Wind Ensemble.

### **Eligibility**

The concerto competition is open to Florida high school musicians (grades 9-12) who play woodwind, brass or percussion instruments. The student must reside in the state of Florida.

### **Application Guidelines**

- Applicants must provide an unedited VHS or DVD video recording with piano accompaniment of the first or last movement of a work for their instrument from the approved repertoire list below.
- Application form, recording and non-refundable \$25.00 application fee (check payable to First Coast Wind Ensemble) must be postmarked by March 1, 2012 and sent together in one packet to: FCWE Concerto Competition Committee, Music Department, Jacksonville University, 2800 University Blvd. North, Jacksonville, FL 32211.
- Applicants will be notified by March 12 regarding their selection as a finalist in the live audition.
- Live auditions will be held before a selection committee at Jacksonville University on Saturday, March 31. Finalists are required to provide their own accompanist for the audition. Finalists are not required to perform from memory.
- The winner will be announced by April 4. The decision of the judges is final.

March 1 - Application packet due

March 31 - Competition Finals held at Jacksonville University

April 22 - Winner will perform with the First Coast Wind Ensemble and receive a \$1,000. cash award.
